



SOLAS/ISM--ISO--OHSAS Standards

Implementation of the SOLAS/ISM (**S**), ISO 9001 (**Q**), ISO 14001 (**E**), and the OHSAS 18001 (**H**) standards into the daily operations, lead to the acquisition of certifications via the American Bureau of Shipping (ABS). These certifications provide the clients with third party verification that the safety, quality, environmental and health systems comply with the stringent business standards. To verify these certifications are being upheld, ABS, the independent classification society, audits the RTC office annually; to ensure compliance with these standards. Additionally, ABS also conducts scheduled verification audits on the tugs.

Reinauer's ISO 9001 Quality Management system includes elements with documented policies, forms, procedure's and instructions adhering to the international Quality standard; as well as company requirements. An internal audit program is in place to ensure compliance.

Similar to ISO 9001, ISO 14001 is the international standard of Environmental Management. The Environmental Management system also includes elements with documented policies, forms, procedure's and instructions adhering to the international Environmental standard; as well as company and regulatory requirements. The same internal audit program is in place to ensure compliance. There is a working Operational Matrix that addresses the impact on the environment which is updated annually.

The Occupational Health and Safety Assessment Series , OHSAS 18001 is a British Standard that Reinauer has recently acquired as a valued added service for our cliental. This standard was specifically designed to work synergistically with the ISO 9001 and ISO 140001 standards. It is natural for Reinauer to implement such a standard into its weave. The success of the system depends on commitment from all levels and functions of Reinauer, and especially from top management. The overall aim of this OHSAS standard is to support and promote quality occupational health and safety practices; to raise an awareness within our work force that emanates through our service.
